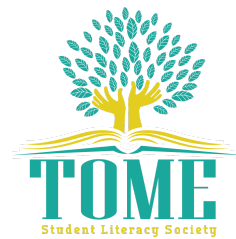


Out of Range

Pre-reading questions

1. The importance of family relationships is one of the themes of *Out of Range*. Have you read any other books that have a similar theme? What are your predictions for how this theme will play out in the book?
2. What comes to mind when you look at the cover of *Out of Range*? What predictions can you make about the setting and plot from looking at the book's cover?
3. Why did you choose to read *Out of Range*? Do you think you will like it? Why?
4. Have you ever gone hiking on an unfamiliar trail? Did you ever have feelings of being lost? What did you do?

Post-reading questions

1. Did you like how this book ended? Were you surprised by it? If you could change the ending of this book, how would you change it and why?
2. Which character could you identify with? Why?
3. What were some valuable lessons that each of the main characters learned in the story?
4. In the story, the main characters discover that their relationship to one another is important. What do you think was the turning point for this discovery?
5. How did nature act as the villain throughout the story? Was nature the only villain in the story? Explain.
6. Explain how the title of the book is appropriate. What about the name of the camp - "Camp Unplugged"? Is that a fitting name for the camp? How?
7. The author used flashbacks throughout the book. Why did she do that? Explain its importance.
8. If you could change something about one of the characters, what would you change? Why?
9. Have you read another book that is similar to this book? If so, what was it? How was it related to this book? Explain why others might want to read it as well.
10. How did this book relate to the Tome Society 2023-2024 Annual Theme, "Brave on Purpose"?

Post-reading activities

1. Create a storyboard on which you summarize the important events from *Out of Range*. Illustrate your storyboard as well.
2. Write a short story from the point of view of one of the characters from *Out of Range*. Within your story, create a new ending for the book. Submit your completed project to the Tome Society It List Fan Fiction competition.
3. Design a book cover for *Out of Range*. Follow the guidelines for the Tome Book Cover Redesign competition and submit your final project to the competition.
