Pre-reading questions:

- 1. One of the main characters in this book is labeled as a coward from his birth because of something one of his ancestors did. What do you think makes a person a coward?
- 2. One of the main characters in the book is 13. The other is a recent high school graduate. Both are soldiers in the war. Think about yourself being forced to fight in a war when you were only 13. What were you doing on a normal day at age 13 in your life?
- **3.** Unfortunately, even though World War II is over, there are many child soldiers around the world in corrupt countries. Read this article to learn more about child soldiers today https://www.dosomething.org/us/facts/11-facts-about-child-soldiers.

Post-reading questions:

- 1. Think about Hideki and Ray. Their story lines were separate but interconnected. What was the difference in your feelings when reading as Ray versus Hideki?
- 2. Grenade story has many intense scenes. However, these were a reality during World War II. Think about Ray's struggle after the boy sniper and Hard Luck were killed. Do you think Sergeant Meredith's explanation would have comforted you?
- 3. Explain why Ray choose to become a solider even though his father's war experience still haunted him.
- 4. Explain how Hideki's feelings about being a coward changed from the beginning of the book until the end.
- 5. How was the theme of the book intertwined with significance of the pictures that Hideki carried?
- 6. Choose one quote from the book that you found to be moving or memorable. Explain why you choose this quote.

Post-reading Activities

- 1. Read the "Author's Note" at the end of the book. What did you find to be the most impactful from these pages?
- 2. Do more research about child soldiers and then create an infographic sharing your findings. Create the infographic following the Tome Competition guidelines at www.tomesociety.org/competitions to submit your competition for Tome.
