



## Tome Book Award Fan Art Competition Instructions

Individual Spring Competition	One Entry Per Chapter Level

**Objective:** Create a piece of original 2D fan art based on a current Tome Book award book from your grade level's list.

### Learning Targets:

- **Character Insight:** Deepened understanding of characters by visually interpreting their traits, emotions, and development from the book.
- **Theme Exploration:** Enhanced grasp of key themes and symbols by representing them visually in the fan art.
- **Artistic Expression:** Improved artistic skills and creativity through drawing and conceptualizing scenes or elements from the book.
- **Literary Connection:** Strengthened connection to the book by translating textual descriptions and imagery into visual art.
- **Critical Thinking:** Enhanced ability to analyze and choose which aspects of the book to illustrate, making decisions based on importance and personal interpretation.
- **Attention to Detail:** Developed an eye for detail by capturing specific features and nuances from the book in the artwork.

### Final Product Guidelines:

- Must be submitted as a sharable link (i.e. file saved to Google Docs, DropBox, etc.)
  - If not created digitally, scan the artwork and submit digitally.
- **Must clearly be the student's own original work - NO AI ALLOWED.**
- Should be excellent work.
- Should be a one-page, 2-D drawing, created by the student, either via digital drawing tools or traditional drawing/painting tools (pencils, markers, pen, paint, charcoal, etc.)
- Should be based on a Tome Book Award book for the current school year from the student's grade level list that the student has read entirely.
- Finished documents (2 files) should include:
  - Cover Page document including:
    - Student's name
    - Student's school name
    - Student's grade
    - Image of Tome Book Award book cover on which the fan art is based
    - Short paragraph explaining the planning and creation of the artwork. Use this space to prove that you made the piece and did not use AI.

- Short paragraph explaining the artwork to the judge - who or what is pictured, what elements of the plot or setting are depicted, what scene is depicted, etc.
- Fan Art drawing including:
  - A descriptive title
  - Student Name/Signature
  - Title of the book
  - Author of the book
  - Student created image depicting a character or scene from the Tome Book Award book
